

## Privacy policy

## What information about you do we collect?

### **Personally identifiable information**

Unless you choose to leave a message, and include personal information as part of that process, these web pages will collect no personally identifiable details about your visit to our web site.

### **Non-personally identifiable information**

We record details for statistical purposes about visitors to our web pages but this in non-personally identifiable information. Typically it may include user IP addresses, browser type, domain name, and other anonymous statistical data involving the use of our Website. This aggregated information is used to help us understand how many people are using different parts of the website, and to improve the content and structure.
