

Notice of Ground Investigation surveys between Sutton Road and Bagley Lane, Tamworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent will need to move underground gas pipelines to allow for the construction of the new railway. To allow us to plan the movement of these pipelines and have a full understanding of local ground conditions, we will need to carry out surveys in the area. These surveys will take place between September and late October.

What are we doing?

Cadent will be carrying out a diversion to an existing pipeline that runs in the fields between Sutton Road and Bagley Lane. The pipeline supplies the local area and we need to carry out the work to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply during HS2's construction and ongoing operation.

The work will include:

1. Setting up of a temporary compound on land north of Sutton Road. Signage may be installed on the roadside, at this location, to ensure safe access and exit for vehicles.
2. Carry out surveys including the drilling of boreholes and digging small pits so we can take samples of the ground to analyse.

How will this affect you?

The majority of vehicles we will be using will be four wheel drive pick-up trucks, with some machinery being delivered to site using Large Goods Vehicles. We don't anticipate the level of these traffic movements will have any significant impact on the local road network.

Duration of work

- The work is planned to take place between 24 September and 31 October 2018.
- Our working hours will be Monday – Friday from 8.00am to 6.00pm.
- We will be on-site one hour, either side of these times, for set-up and close-down.

What to expect

- Low levels of noise from our equipment.
- We may install signage on the roadside where we access our worksite.
- We may install temporary fencing to maintain a safe working environment.

What we will do

- Inform you in advance of any changes to these works.
- Keep all sites safe and secure.
