**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
Drayton Lane
Drayton Bassett**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 6th July 2021 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Drayton Lane in Drayton Bassett from its junction with Portleys Road to its junction with Church Close, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access will be maintained by operatives on site.

The order will come into operation on 15th July 2021 and the said works (which will take place between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30) will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed on the same day.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the overhead works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
